At the General Assembly of the Province of Nova Scotia, begun and holden at Halifax, on Thursday the Eleventh day of February, 1819; and continued by several Prorogations until Thursday, the Tenth day of February, 1820, in the Sixtieth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith &c. &c. being the Second Session of the Eleventh General Assembly, convened in the said Province.

60 George III – Chapter 21

An Act to continue an Act, entitled, "An Act in addition to and amendment of an Act, passed in the forty-first year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled, 'An Act for repairing, cleansing, and paving, the Streets in the Town and Peninsula of Halifax, and for removing obstructions therein;" and also, the Act, in amendment thereof, passed in the forty-second year of His Majesty's Reign.

Be it enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, that an act, passed in the fiftieth year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, "An Act in addition to and in amendment of an Act, passed in the forty-first year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled, 'An Act for repairing, cleansing and paving, the Streets in the Town and Peninsula of Halifax, and for removing obstructions therein." And also, the act, in amendment thereof, passed in the forty-second year of His Majesty's reign, and every matter, clause and thing, in the said act contained, shall be continued for one year, and from thence to the end of the next session of the general assembly.
