Grand and Petit Jurors

III. And be it further enacted, That the Grand and Petit Jurors shall respectively serve for faid Inserior Courts of Common Pleas and General Sessions of the Peace, in the Township of Amherst and County of Cumberland, on the last Tuesday of April, and second Tuesday of November, in each year: any law, usage or custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.
