and paving, the Streets in the Town and Peninfula of Halifax, and for removing obftructions therein, and every matter, claufe and thing, therein contained, fave and except the first and tenth clauses thereof, be extended, and the same are hereby extended, to the Town of Windfor.

II. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawiul for the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of His Majefly's Council, to nominate and appoint three fit and proper perfons, Inhabitants of the Town of Windsor, to be Commissioners for the repairing, paving, and keeping in repair, the Streets and Lanes of the faid Town, and for afcertaining and removing obstructions therein ; and, in case of the death, removal or refusal, of any of the Commissioners to appointed, his or their places, from time to time, to be filled up by fuch perfon or perfone, being Inhabitants of the faid Town, and respectable Freeholders there, as the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief, for the time being, with the advice of His Majefty's Council, shall nominate and appoint.

III. And be it further enacled, That the limits of the faid Town, subject to the controul and superintendance of the Commissioners, so to be appointed as aforesaid, shall extend from the Island, called Smith's Island, to the Northward and Eastward as far as the Bridge over the Trecothic Creek, on the main road leading out of the Town of Windsor as far as the Church; and on the Southward and Westward to the Falmouth Ferry.

IV. And be it further enacted, That, from and after the first day of May next, the power and authority now vested in the Surveyors of Highways, within the limits above described, in the faid Township, shall cease and determine, any law, usage or custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.

## CAP. XVII.

DE it enacted by the Lieuterant Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, peffed in the Act 50th Geo. D fiftieth year of His late Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act in addition to an Act, paffed in the thirty-third year of the leign of His late Majesty King George the Second, entitled, An Act for regulating the Rates and Prices of Carriages, and every matter, claufe and thing, therein contained, shall be continued, and the same is hereby continued for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Seffion of the General Affembly.

## CAP. XVIII.
