## CAP. XIX.

An ACT to continue the leveral Acts now in force, regulating the expenditure of Monies for the fervice of Roads and Bridges.

Acts 52d, 57th and 60th Geo. 111. continued, with exceptions

**B** it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, paffed in the fifty-fecond year of His late Majefty's reign, entitled, An Act to regulate the expenditure of Monies hereafter to be appropriated for the fervice of Roads and Bridges (except so far as the faid Act is altered by the Acts hereinafter named) Alfo an Act, paffed in the fifty-feventh year of His late Majefty's reign, to alter and amend the faid Act (except so far as the faid laft mentioned Act is altered by the Act hereinafter named.) And alfo an Act, paffed in the fixtieth year of His late Majefty's reign, to alter and continue the faid Acts, and every matter, claufe and thing, in the faid Acts contained, (excepting as before excepted) fhall be continued, and the fame are hereby continued, for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Seffion of the General Affembly.

## CAP. XX.

An ACT to continue an Act, made and paffed in the thirty-eighth year of His late Majefty's reign, entitled, An Act-to amend and render more effectual an Act, paffed in the eighteenth year of His prefent Majefty's reign, entitled, An Act to prevent foreftalling, regrating and monopolizing, of Cord Wood in the Town of Halifax; and, also, the Act now in force, in addition thereto.

III. continued BE it enacled-by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, 'That an Act, made and paffed in the thirty eighth year of His late Majetty's Reign, entitled, An Act to amend and render more effectual an Act, paffed in the eighteenth year of His prefent Maj-fty's reign, entitled, An Act to prevent foreftalling, regrating and monopolizing, of Cord Wood, in the Town of Halifax; and alfo, an Act, paffed in the fifty eighth year of His late Majefty's reign, entitled, An Act in addition to the Acts to prevent the foreftalling Cord Wood : and every matter, claufe and thing, in the faid Acts contained, fhall be continued, and the fame are hereby continued for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Seffion of the General Affembly.
