## "C. XXI-XXII-XXIII. Anno tertio Georgii IV.

CAP. XXI.

An ACT to continue an A&, entitled, An A& in addition to and in amendment of an A&, paffed in the forty-first year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled, An A& for repairing, cleansing and paving, the Streets in the Town and Peninsula of Halifax, and and for removing obstructions therein; and also, the A& in amendment thereof, passed in the forty-fecond year of His present Majesty's Reign.

**B** E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, paffed in the 'Act 50th, Geo. fittieth year of His late Majefty's Reign, entitled, An Act in addition to, and in 'Ill continued amendment of, an Act, paffed in the forty-first year of His Majefty's Reign, entitled, An Act for repairing, cleanfing and paving, the Streets, in the Town and Peninfula of Halifax, and for removing obstructions therein ; and also the Act, in amendment thereof, passed in the forty-fecond year of His late Majefty's Reign, and every matter, clause and thing, in the faid Act contained, shall be continued, and the fame is hereby continued in force for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Affembly.

## CAP XXII.

An ACT to continue the Act to provide for the accommodation and billetting of His Majefty's Troops, or of the Militia, when on their march from one part of the Province to another; and alfo the Acts in amendment thereof.

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, made in the forty-eighth year of His late Majefty's Reign, entitled, An Act to provide for the accommodation and billetting of His Majefty's Troops, or of the Militia, when on their match from one parc of the Province to another; and alfo, the Acts paffed in the fifty-firft and fifty-third years of His late Majefty's Reign, in amendment thereof; and every matter, claufe and thing, in the faid Acts contained, fhall be continued, and the fame are hereby continued in force for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Seffion of the General Affembly.

## CAP. XXIII.

An ACT to continue the feveral Acts of the General Assembly, for raising a Revenue to repair the Roads throughout the Province, by laying a Duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed to keep Public Houses and Shops, for the retail of Spirituous Liquors.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act, passed in the thirty-ninth year of His late Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for raising a Revenue
