An ACT for applying certain Monies therein mentioned, for the service of the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-two; and for appropriating fuch part of the Supplies granted in this Session of the General Assembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province.

May it please Your Excellency,

E, His Majefty's dutiful and lawful Subjects, the Houfe of Affembly of His Majefty's Province of Nova-Scotia, towards appropriating the Supplies granted to His Majefty in this Seffion of the General Affembly, and for supplying the Exigencies of His Majefty's Government, do humbly befeech that it may be enacted, and,

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That, by or out of fuch Monies as now are, or from time to time shall be and remain, in the Public Treasury of this Province, there shall be paid :---

fervices performed by him, and his Deputy or Deputies, and the fees received by him and them, it fhall appear to the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief, for the time being, that a reafonable compensation has not been received by the faid Sheriff for those fervices, it shall be lawful for His Excellency, to draw by Warrant on the Treasfury, such such not exceeding fifty pounds, to be paid to the faid Sheriff, as in the opinion of the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief, shall be neceffary to remurerate the faid Sheriff, for the fervices performed ty him during the faid year, it appearing that from the prefent flate of the Roads in that County, the execution of the Office of Sheriff is attended with great difficulty.

V. And be it further enacted, That if any accident thall happen to any of the Bildges on the Main Roads in this Province, or any unforefeen obstructions to travelling thall arife from the fall of trees or otherwife, it thall and may be lawful for His Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief, for the time being, to order a Commiffioner or Commiffioners to repair or rebuild tuch Bridges, or to remove fuch obstructions. And it thall and may be further lawful, for the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, to draw Warrants on account, and in favor, of fuch Commiffioners or Commiffioners: provided, the fame thall not exceed the fum of Five Hundred Pounds.

VI. And be it further enacled, That the ninth, twelfth, fifteenth, fixteenth, eighteenth and nineteenth, fections or claules of the Act, made and paffed in the forty-first year of His late Majesty's reign, entitled, "An Act for applying certain Monies therein mentioned, for the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one, and for appropriating such part of the Supplies granted in this Session of the General Assembly as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province," shall be and continue in full force and virtue until the twenty-fifth day of March, which will be in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three, in as full and ample a manner as the same clauses would be were they again here repeated word for word.
