AND WHEREAS, the great increase of Smuggling makes it necessary to give greater encouragement to persons making Scizurcs, and to authorise all persons employed by the Collector of Impost and Excise at Halifax, as Waiters or extra Waiters, to make scizures :

III. Be it therefore enacled, That each and every perfon employed by the Collector of Impoft and Excife for the Diffrict of Halifax, as a Watter, extra Waiter, or temporary Waiter, fhall have all the powers and authority to enter on board of any Ship or Veffel, and to Seize any Ship, Veffel, Boat, Cart, Waggon, Truck, Sled or Horfe, and to fue for any penalty or penalties that are now by law peffeffed by the Collector, Land Waiter or Guager; and the perfon making any Seizure, or profecuting for any penalty, fhall be entitled to one half of tuch beizure or Penalty, and no Officer or person employed in the fervice of the Provincial Revenue, fhall be entitled to any part of any Seizure or penalty, save and except the Officer or person who fhall actually have made the Seizure, or fhall have been the means of recovering any such penalty or penalties.

## CAP. IX.

An ACT to continue an Act, entitled, An Act to amend and continue the leveral Acts imposing a Duty on Articles to be imported from the United States of America.

E it enacted by the Licutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That the Act, paffed in the laft Seffion of the General Affembly, entitled, An Act to amend and continue the feveral Acts imposing a Duty on Articles to be imported from the United States of Ametica, be continued, and the fame, with every matter, claufe, and thing, therein contained, is hereby continued, until the twenty-fitth day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord one thouland eight hundred and twenty-three, and no longer.

## CAP. X.

An ACT to continue an Act, for granting a Drawback of the Duties on Brown or Raw Sugar, used in the Manufacture of Refined Sugar within the Province, and for regulating the mode of obtaining the fame.

BE it enacled by the Licutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That the Act, paffed in the fifty leventh year of His late Majelty's Keign, entitled, An Act for granting a Drawback of the Duties on Brown or Raw Sugar, used in the Manufacture of refined Sugar within the Province, and for regulating the mode of obtaining the fame, be continued, and the fame, with every matter, claufe and thing, therein contained, is hereby continued until the twenty-fifth day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three, and no longer.
