**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the third Year of His present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for the Summary Trial of Actions; and every matter, clause and thing, in the said Act contained, shall be continued, and the same is hereby continued, for one Year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly.

## CAP. IX.

An ACT in addition to and amendment of an Act, entitled, An Act to regulate the Appointment of Collectors, and other Officers of Import and Excise.

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That, from and after the publication of this Act, it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, to enlarge or limit any of the Districts or Ports for which any Collector of Import and Excise hath been, or shall hereafter be, appointed, and to define the limits and bounds of such District or Port in the Commission of such Collector, any thing in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
