## CAP. XI.

An ACT to alter an Act, passed in the thirty-second year of His late Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for the further increase of the Revenue by raising a Duty of Excise on all Goods, Wares and Merchandise, imported into this Province.

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That, from and after the Contraband Goods found in publication of this Act, it any Goods, Wares or Merchandise, shall be found in possession of the custody or possession of any Shopkeeper or Trader, of the value of Five Pounds, or Shopkeepers, upwards, without a certificate that the Duty of Excite has been paid or secured thereon, sepursuant to the provisions of the Act, passed in the thirty-second year of His late Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act for the further increase of the Revenue by raising a Duty of Excise on all Goods, Wares or Merchandise, imported into this Province, such Shopkeeper or Trader shall be subject, for such offence, to a penalty not less than Five Pounds. nor exceeding Fifty Pounds, to be recovered by bill, plaint, or information, in any of His Majesty's Course of Record, by any person who will prosecute and sue for the same : one half of the penalty to go to the informer, the other half to the King wfor the use of the Province.

II. And be it further endcted, That this Act, and every matter and thing therein con- Continuation of tained, shall be and continue in force until the twenty afth day of March, which will be in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty four, and no longer.

## CAP. XII.

An ACT in addition to an Act, passed in the sifty-eighth year of Hislate Majesty's Reign, entitled. An Act to empower the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, to issue Treasury Notes.

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That it shall and may Further isono be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, Notes by Warrant, or otherwise, to direct the Commissioners appointed under the faid Act, entitled, An Act to empower the Lieutenant-Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being to issue Treasury Notes, or any other Act, now in force, relating to Treasury Notes, to make a further issue of Treasury Notes to any amount, not exceeding Five Thousand Pounds : the said Notes, to to be issued, shall be One Pound Notes, Amount and description of and Two Pound Notes, and shall bear date the First Day of June, One Thousand Eight Notes to be is-Hundred and Twenty-three, and be of the same form, figned, countersigned and deli- weed vered, and shall be paid, and received in payment, in like manner, and again re-issued, under the rules, regulations, restrictions, paine, penalties and provisions, as are mentioned and contained in the said Act of which this is an addition.
