CAP. XXXVI.

An ACT to make further provision for the Administration of Juffice in the County of Cape-Breton.

Preamble

HEREAS it is deemed necessary to make some further provision for the Administration of Justice in the County of Cape Breton :

Appointment of Chief-Instice of Cape-Breton

1. BE it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, That it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief for the time being, to appoint one fit and proper Person, who shall have been regularly admitted and sworn as an Attorney of His Majesty's Supreme Court of this Province, and who Mall have prastifed as an Attorney of the said Court for at least five years after such admission, to be Chief-Justice of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas for the said County of Cape-Breton, and President, or First Justice, of the Court of Sessions, in and for the faid County.

Chief-Justice terior Courts and Courts of General Sessi-.... Salars Traveling expenses of Chief-Justice.

II. And be it surther enacted, That the person, so appointed, shall preside as the First togressie at In- Juffice in all and every of the Sittings of the faid Inferior Court of Common Pleas, for the faid County of Cape-Breton, and in all and every of the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace, in and for the skid County.

> III. And be it further enacted. That there shall be allowed and paid, as the yearly Salary of such Judge, the futh of Pour Hundred Pounds, and that the further fum of One Hundred Pounds shall annually be allowed and paid to him, in lieu of all travelling fees and incidental charges.

CAP. XXXVII

An ACT to continue an Act, entitled, An Act in addition to and amendment of an Act, passed in the forty-first year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act for repairing, cleansing and paving, the Streets, in the Town and Peninfula of Halifax, and for removing Obstructions therein; and also the Act in amendment thereof, passed in the forty-second year of His present Majesty's reign.

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, passed in I the fiftieth year of His late Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act in addition to and in amendment of an Act, passed in the forty-first year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act for repairing, cleaning and paving, the Streets in the Town and Peninsula of Halifax, and for removing obstructions therein; and also the Act in amendment thereof, passed in the forty-second year of His late Majelty's reign, and every matter, clause and thing, in the said Acts contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued, for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Affembly.
