and bufhes, for logs, poles and brufhwood, to repair the faid Roads, and the damage done thereby shall be appraifed and afcertained by the judgment of three indifferent freeholders, to be nominated by the nearest Justice of the Peace, for that purpose, and the fum fo afcertained shall be paid by the Commissioner to the Owner of the foil, if demanded within three months from luch appraisement.

Actions against Commissioners

XVII. And be it further enacted, That in cafe any Action shall be brought against either of the faid Commissioners, fo to be appointed as aforefaid, by reason of any thing done by him in the execution of his Office as Commiffioner as aforefaid, he may plead the general issue thereto, and give this Act, and the fpecial matter, in evidence on the trial of fuch Action.

Encroachments or obstructions upon Roads

XVIII. And be it further enacted, That the faid Commissioner or Commissioners shall examine the breadth of the Roads within their respective Diffricts, and when it shall appear that any encroachments or obstructions have been made, put or placed, in or upon the fame, the faid Commissioner or Commissioners shall, forthwith, give notice to the Owner or Occupier of the Land adjoining the said Road, that unless the faid Road shall be opened and cleared to its proper breadth within thirty days, the perfonor perfons who shall have erected or continued the obstruction, will be profecuted as the Law directs.

Return of En-Courts of Sessions

XIX. And be it further enacted, That the faid Commissioners shall make an accurate croachments to return of the breadth of all fuch Roads, and of the incumbrances thereon, to His Majesty's Supreme Court, or Court of General Seffions of the Peace, for the County or District where the offence shall have been committed, at its next fitting, after the appointment of fuch Commissioner or Commissioners, in order that fuch proceedings may be thereupon had, as to the faid Court shall be deemed neceffary and proper to carry into effect the provisions of the Act relating to Highways, Roads and Bridges, and for preventing Nuifances.

XX. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall continue in force for three years, Continuation of Act and from thence to the end of the next Seffion of the General Affembly.

CAP. XV.

An ACT to continue an Act, entitled, An Act more effectually to fecure the payment of the Provincial Duties of Excife, and to prevent Frauds in the collection of the Provincial Revenue.

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, That the Act, made and passed in the third year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act more effectually to fecure the payment of the Provincial Duties of Excife, and to prevent Frauds in the collection of the Provincial Revenue, and every matter, claufe and thing, in the faid Act contained, shall be continued, and the same is hereby continued, for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly,
