An ACT to continue an Act, entitled, An Act for the better prefervation of the Property of the Inhabitants of the Town of Halifax by providing for a fufficient Watch at Night.

B E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, passed in Acts 58th Geo. the fifty-eighth year of His late Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act for the better 111. continued prefervation of the Property of the Inhabitants of the Town of Halifax, by providing for a sufficient Watch at Night, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, thall be continued, and the same is hereby continued, for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly.

CAP. XVII.

An Act to continue the Act to provide for the Accommodation and Billetting of His Majesty's Troops, or of the Militia, when on their march from one part of the Province to another; and alfo the Acts in amendment thereof.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, made in Acts 48th, 51st the forty-eighth year of His late Majefty's reign, entitled, An Act to provide for and 53d, Geo. the accommodation and billetting of His Majefty's Troops, or of the Militia, when on their march from one part of the Province to another; and also the Acts, paffed in the fifty-first and fifty-third years of His late Majefty's reign, in amendment thereof, and every matter, clause and thing, in the faid Acts contained, shall be continued, and the fame are hereby continued, for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Seffion of the General Affembly.

CAP. XVIII;

An ACT to alter and continue the feveral Acts to provide for the greater fecurity of this Province by a better regulation of the Militia, and to repeal the Militia Laws now in force.

B *it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly*, That an Act, made and Acts ^{9,3} paffed in the fecond year of His prefent Majetty's reign, entitled, An Act to ^{4th t} ^{cont} and to repeal the Militia Laws now in force; and alfo, an Act, paffed in the fourth year of His faid Maiefty's Reign, entitled, An Act to alter and continue an Act to pro-H
