II. And be it further enacted, That it shall not be lawful to take, under and by virtue to Attachment, of any Writ of Attachment, Execution, or other Process (except for rent,) the grain, until severed hay, potatoes, or other article growing in the ground, before the same shall be fevered ground from the ground.

III. And be it further enacted, That hereafter no Writ of Attachment shall be issued tashment can in any case, except against Absent or Absconding Debtors, and for the recovery of against Absent Debts contrasted prior to the passing of this Act. Debtors

IV. And be it further enacled, That the Sheriff, or his Deputy, or other Officer, to Poundage alwhom any Writ of Attachment shall be directed, shall not, on any pretence, take lowed to Shepoundage for levying the same, on a greater amount than the appraised value of the riff property attached, and in no case shall such poundage be taken, on a greater sum, than that sworn to, and endorsed on such Writ.

V. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall be in full force and effect for Five Continuance of Years from the publication thereof, and from thene to the end of the next Session of the General Assessment.

CAP. VIII.

An ACT to alter, amend and continue, an Act for confolidating, and reducing into one Act, all the Acts, heretofore made, relating to Trefpaffes.

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That an Act, made and Act 3d Geo: paffed in the third Year of His prefeut Majefty's Reign, entitled, An Act for IV. continued consolidating, and reducing into one Act, all the Acts, heretofore made, relating to Trespaffes, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, except fuch parts thereof as are hereby altered and amended, be continued, and the fame is hereby continued, for three Years, and from thence to the end of the next Seffion of the General Affembly.

Whereas, difficulties have arisen in committing of Trespassers to Jail, who refuse and neglect to pay

the Fines imposed by the said Act :

II. Be it therefore enacted, That in all Cases, where a recovery shall be had before one Recovery of Justice of the Peace, for any sum of Money under and by virtue of this Act, that the Fines imposed upon Trespass fame shall be levied and collected in the fame manner as in cases of other debts recover- sers able before one Justice, and by the form of Execution now in use; and the Defendant

or Defendants, shall be liable to be imprisoned for want of Goods and Chattles under fuch Execution, as in cases of other Debts as aforefaid.

And Whereas, the time of six months has been found too limited a period for commencing Prosecutions

under this Act :

Time extended III. Be it therefore enacted, That, from and after the publication of this Act, it shall for commencing Prosecutions and may be lawful for any Perlou or Perfons entitled thereto, to commence such profecutions at any time within one year from the time of the committing of the offence.

CAP. IX.

An ACT to continue an Act for establishing a Bridewell, or House of Correction, for the County of Halifax, and for providing a Police Office in faid Town, with proper Officers to attend the _ fame.

Act 55th Geo. The fifty-fifth year of His late Majefty's reign, entitled, An Act for eftablishing a Bridewell or House of Correction for the County of Halifax, and for providing a Police Office in faid Town, with proper Officers to attend the fame, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, be continued, and the fame is hereby continued, for One year, and from thence to the end of the next Seffion of the General Affembly.

CAP. X.

An Act to repeal feveral Acts of the General Affembly, paffed to prevent foreftalling, regrating and monopolizing.

WHEREAS the several Acts hereinafter recited have been found ineffectual and injurious in their operation :

Acts 32d Geo. II. and 6th Geo. III. repealed I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenont-Governor, Council and Allembly. That the Act, paffed in the thirty-fecond year of the Reign of His Majefty King George the Second, entitled, An Act to prevent foreftalling the Market; and allo, the Act paffed, in the fixth year of His late Majefty King George the Third, entitled, An Act against Foreftallers and Regrators, and every matter, claufe and thing, in the faid Acts contained, be, and the fame are hereby, repealed.
