An ACT to alter and continue the several Acts relating to the Light-House erected on Cranberry Island, near the entrance of the Gut of Canso.

F it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That an Act, passed in the third year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act to provide for the support of a Light-House, erected on Cranberry Island, near the entrance of the Gut of Canfo; also the Act, passed in the fourth year of His said Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act to continue, alter and amend, an Act, passed in the third year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act to provide for the support of a Light-House erected on Cranberry Island, near the entrance of the Gut of Canso; and every matter, clause and thing, in the said Acts contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued, for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly.

Light Duty imposed upon Coasting Vessels belonging to the adjacent British Provinces II. Proided always, and be it further enacted, That every Coasting Vessel, not exceeding the burthen of sixty-sive tons, owned and registered in the adjacent British Provinces, shall pay, in lieu of the Duties by the Acts hereinbefore continued imposed, the sum of Twenty Shillings for each and every year, and no more: to be received and recovered as in and by the said Acts is provided.

CAP. XXVII.

An ACT to continue an Act, entitled, An Act to repeal the feveral Acts of the General Assembly, passed to prevent forestalling, regrating and monopolizing.

BE it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the fourth year of His present Majesiy's Reign, entitled, An Act to repeal several Acts of the General Assembly, passed to prevent forestalling, regrating and monopolizing; and every matter, clause and thing, in the said Act contained, be, and the same is hereby, continued in sorce, for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly.
