

## CAP. XXX.

An ACT to continue an Act in addition to an Act, passed in the thirty-third year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, entitled, An Act for regulating the rates and prices of Carriages.

Act continued

**B**E it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That an Act, passed in the fiftieth year of His late Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act in addition to an Act, passed in the thirty-third year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, entitled, An Act for regulating the rates and prices of Carriages, and every matter, clause and thing, herein contained, shall be continued, and the same is hereby continued, for one year, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly.

## CAP. XXXI.

An ACT in amendment of an Act, passed in the fourth year of His present Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act to regulate the Jurisdiction of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas within the County of Cape-Breton, and to fix and establish the times and places for holding the said Inferior Court and General Sessions of the Peace in and for the said County.

Time of sitting of Court of Common Pleas in the western District of Cape Breton

**B**E it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That, from and after the publication of this Act, the Inferior Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions of the Peace for the Western District of the said County of Cape-Breton, shall be held on the first Tuesday of October in each and every year.

## CAP. XXXII.

An ACT to amend and continue an Act, made and passed in the thirty-eighth year of His Majesty's reign, entitled, An Act to amend and render more effectual, an Act, passed in the eighteenth year of His present Majesty's Reign, entitled, An Act to prevent forestalling, regrating and monopolizing, of Cord Wood in the Town of Halifax; and also, the Act, now in force, in addition thereto.
