carrying away Cattle, Sheep or Lambs in
Dorset and its Dependencies.

Whereasundry Persons have
lately and do frequently in a Landstots manner
Shoot at, Maim, Maim or Kill and carry away
Cattle, Sheep or Lambs - the Property of the
Inhabitants from the Commons and Places
where they run at large by which means
it is not in the Power of the owners to detect
them for remedy whereof.

Be it Ordained & Ordered by
the Lieutenant Governor by and with the
advice and Consent of His Majesty's Council
and by the Authority of the same it is
hereby Ordained and Ordered - That
if any Person or Persons shall Maliciously
and Wilfully, Kill, Maim, Maim or
otherwise

Otherwise hurt or carry away any Horses
Sheep or other Cattle every such Offender or
Offenders shall lose and forfeit unto the
Party aggrieved treble the Damage which
he or they shall sustain, to be recovered by
Action of Trespass or upon the Case in
any of His Majesty's Courts of Record in
Capetown or Its Dependences.
