

any Coals taken from any place on this Island or its Dependencies without having a permit for the same signed by His Eccellency the Governor, Sienten = = and Govennor, or the Commander in Chief for the time being, every such Vefsel or Boat shall be subject to forfeiture and the Cargo on board the same, and also all the Jung, Furriture, ammunition, Tackle, and Apparel to such Vefice or Boat helonging - By and Ordered by the authority aforesaid, that all forfeitures incurred by this Ordinance shall and may be prosecuted, sued for and recovered in any Court of Record in this Sand And it is hereby further Ordained and Ordered that all forfeitures so recovered under this Ordinance shall be paid and applied as follows That is to say, after deducting the changes of prosecution from the Grofs produce thereof, and all such Duties as belong and appertain to His Mayesty on the Coals to seized and forfeited, the remaining het produce shall be paid to him or them who shall seize onform and sue for the same -And it is hereby further Ordained and Ordered by the authority aforesaid. that if any Vefiel or Boat shall be seized for any cause of forfution under
