Merelles it has been found by Experience that the good purposes intended by the said Ordinance made and passed as a foresaid have not been effected, and that some further Rules and Regulations are necessary to prevent the Inconveniences and disorders occasioned by the aforementioned Ordinance being incomplete and desective,

Honor the President, by and with the advice and consent of Chis Majesty's Council, and it is hereby Or dained and Ordered by the authority of the Same, that
the Grand Jury at the Court of General Sessions of
the Peace to be holden for the Body of the Island of
Cape Buton at Sydney mext ensuing the Publication of
this Ordinance and thereafter annually at the same
Term of Sessions of the said Court, Shall Mominate
out of the Inhabitants residing in the Town of Sydney,
Two proper Persons, one of whom the said Court shall as

such matters and things as shall relate and appertan to His office. And Whereas there will not be any Court General Sessions of the Peace, until the first Hednesda in June next, and it being expedient that a Town Cler should be immediately appointed. Be it therefore Ordained and ordered by the authority aforesaid, that until the next meeting of the said General Sessions of the Peace, William Day shall be and he is hereby Improwered to act as Four bleck and Common Herd for the Town of Sydney. And Whereas many Inconveniences have arriver for want of battle being Branded, on otherwise marked, which run in the Common Herd in the Town of Sydney, Be it therefore Ordained and Ordered by the authority aforesaid, That all and every the owner or own ers of any House or Houses, Neat Cattle, Theep or Swine, Pasturing in the Common Herd appertaining to the Town of Tydney, shall brand or otherwise mark all such How or Howes, Meat Cattle, Sheef and Swine in such man = ner as that the same may be clearly known and dis: =tinguished, which mark or Brand shall be Entered with the Town Clerk in a Book to be kept by him for that purpose, and the said Town Clerk, shall receive for Recording the said Mark or Brand the sum of Fifteen pence,

And

Just Debts out of the Effects And Be it further Ordained and Ordered by the Outhority aforesaid, that no person or persons whatsoever 2 whether owner or owners of the said House or Horses, Seat Cattle, Sheep or Swine, or otherwise, shall take drive or carry away from out of the said Common Herd any House on Houses, Neat Cattle, Sheep or Swine, without first giving notice of such their Intention to the said Town blech, who is to attend either by himself or his dufficient Deputy in order to ascertain the exact Mumber and Species so tobe taken driven or Garried away, and that the same is done by the Consent and Know. -ledge of the owner or owners of the same, of which the said Town Clerk is to make an Entry thereof in his Re--gistry, and is to receive for his trouble in this Case the Sum of Three prence for each and every House, Near Cattle, Sheefe or Swine, so taken out of the Common Herd,

And Be it further Ordained and Ordered by the Authority aforesaid, That if any Horse or Houses, Mat Cattle, Sheep or Swine be found running or Pastwring in the Common Heard in the Town of Sydney, without being duly Marked and Entered in the Registry of the Town Clerk as aforesaid, the same may be Impounded in the Common Dound, and there remain until redeemed for which the said owner or Owners shall pay a Fine, that is to say, Ten Shillings for every Horse or weat Cattle, and Two Shillings and Six pence for every their after Good on the Combine of the Said Owner to be applied to Mepairing the Outlier

Oublie Boads in the Fown of Tydney, and whale also pay to the Dound theeper for each and every Bear, of the aforementioned description so Impounded for his trouble, Six pence, and if the Owner or Owners of the sai House or Houses, Neat Gattle, Sheep or Swine, Shale after three days notice of their being so Impounded, Meglector refuse to redeem them in that time, the same may be Publichly Sold and the Fine and Expences attending the Impounding and Sale, to be tetained by the Town Clerk out of the Money arising from our Sale and the remainder or residue to be paid to the Owner or owners thereof, which if he, The, or they refus to receive the same shall and may be applied to: -wards repairing the Public Roads in the said Town of Sydney, And Be it further Ordained and Ordered by the authority aforesaid, That if any Person or Per: sons shall be found Clandestinely taking, driving or Carrying away from the Common Herd of Pasturage in or belonging to the Town of Sydney without the Know; -ledge and Privity of the Town Clerk or Common Herd shall forfeit and pay a fine not exceeding Five , Frounds to be recovered on Complaint or Information before any Two of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, to before the General Sessions of the Peace, next ensuing the Commission of the offence, the vame to be levied by Warrant of Distress and Sale of the Offendors Goods Goods and Chattels, one half to the Prosecutor, and the other to the Public uses of this Government;

And Whereas it appears Essentially Me-

-cefsary for the good of this Government, more fraiti=
-cularly in the Town and Vecenity of Sydney to pre=
-vent as much as possible the Malicious Hilling,

maining or otherwise destroying battle,

The authority aforesaid, that if any Person or Persons shall Maliciously, Unlawfully and Millingly, Mile, Main, or otherwise hurt any Houses, Sheep or other Cattle every such offender or offenders shall loose and forfeit unto the Party grieved, Theble the Damages which he, she, or they shall wustain to be recovered by action of Thespafs or whom the Case in any of His Majesty's Courts of Record in this Government.

by the authority aforesaid that nothing Cautained in this Ordinance is meant or intended to prevent or obstruct the Owner or Owners of any Houses, Mileh Cows, or touching Cattle, to take them out of the Common Head as often as they find it requisite and Necessary, only signifying to the Town Clerk at the time they shall Register their Brand or Mark. That they shall have Occasion to do so from time to time, And it is also ordained and Ordered by the same authority that the Commencement of each Leason for Pasturing of Houses, Near Cattle, Sheep and Swine in the Common Head in the Town
