An Ordinance to continue and Ordinance made & passed in the Forty second Year of His present Majesty's Reign Entitled An Ordinance for Granting to His Majesty a Duty of Impost on Rum & other distilled Spirituous Liquors – And also an Ordinance made and passed in the same year of His present Majesty's Reign in Amendment of and Addition to the Above Recited Ordinances

Whereas the Above Recited Ordinances are near Expiring & it is Expedient they Should be Continued.

Be it Ordained and Ordered by His Honor the – President by and with the Advice and Consent of His Majesty's – Council And by the Authority of the same It is hereby Ordained and Ordered that the said Recited Ordinance and every matter clause and thing in them or either of them contained shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued in force until the Thirty first Day of December which will be in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and Five.

Approved, Ordained & Ordered Accordingly in Council this 12th Day of December in 44th Year of His Majesty's Reign
