Be it Ordained and Ordered by His Honor the
President by and with the Advice and Consent of His Majesty's
Council. And by the Authority of the same it is hereby Ordained
and Ordered, That the said recited Ordinances, and every matter
Clause and Thing in them or either of them contained shall be
continued, and the same are hereby continued in force until the Thirty
first Day of December which will be in the Year of our Lord One
Thousand Eight hundred and Five.
