And Mereas it is found necessary and Ox redients the Cowers given to the said bommissioners in and by the before in part Teceted Ordinance should be enlarged and extended more particularly as to the laying out of the Public Highways. Roads and Bridges in the Said Jolan and its Dependencies, and also to the direction of the Status Labour to be done thereon. Be it therefore Ordained and Ordered by the authority aforesaid. That immediately from and after the Publi -cation hereof in every Township place or Harbour in this Island or its Dependencies, where new highway or common Roads from Town to Town or place to place shall be wanting or where old ways and Roads may be turned or attered with more conven to the Public the said Commissioners appointed now three of them may and shall, and they are hereby authorized and Empowered to lay out the same we ang to their best Skill and Judgement for the Suble good and with the least prejudice or damage to any particular person, and also to direct and info the Statute Labour to be done and performed on Such Aighways or bommon Read so laid out by the

as aforesaid. And all overseers or Surveyors of Highways are hereby enjoyined and directed to obey and carry into effect all such orders and derections as the said Commellyners or any three of them shall signify to them constitute to time in writing lespecting the Statute Labour to be for and performed on such highways Roads or Bridges as aforescued, under the Genalty of Jen Pounds for each and every neglect or omelsion of them, each aring of them the said overseers or Surveyors. The samo to be Tecovered by the said Commissioners or any three of them in His Majestris Supreme Court by Bell -Plaint or Information, and applied as other fines and forfectures are derected to be applied in and by an Ordinance heretofive made and Passed for making and lepaining of Highways. Provided always that when and so often as the said Commessioners shall so lay out and direct any Nighways or Road or atter or turn any old way or Road, they shall give three days notice of such their intentions by putting up the same in the most Public places in such Township place or Harbour where the same Highway or Road is proposed to be made or altered with the entent that if any person shall think himself aggreered or injured thereby he may make complaint thereof to the said Commissioners who are to enquire into the cause of such complaint in order that if the same be found lest they may give such teleef to the Complainant as they are authorized to do in and by the before in part recited Ordinance hereby levided. And Be It further Ordained no and Ordered by the authority aforesaid that the Several Overseers or Surveyors of Highways in the respective -

Townships Places or Harbours in the said Island or its Dependencies shall at the time of their intering in their

office in each and every year give in or Transmit to the said Commissioners a List of the Names of all persons with their respective districts who are hable by Law to perform Statute Labour on the Highways, and at their going our, Thee to account for all Fines and Forfeitures which they may have received during the time they have been in office to the daid Commissioners who are hereby Empowered to directs Expenditure thereof on the Highways or Roads in the Sistered where such fines and forfeitures shall arise, and at the same time the said Overseers or Surveyors are also to deliver to the Commissions conect Lists of all defaulters distinguishing those who have paid and satisfied the fines and forfeitures which they have incurred. . And Be it also ordained an Ordered by the authority aforesand that whenever the Lewitenant Governor. Orindent of Council or Commande in Chuf for the time being shall judge it necessary and Expedient that the Commissioners or any three of them should repair to any of the Townships. Places or Harbour in this Island or its Deprendencees at a distance from the Vicinity of the Foun of Sydney to Execute any part of the duty. He may direct them is any three of them to proceed by the most convenient opportunity to execute the said duty and all the learnable and Unavoidable expence incurred by the said bommissioners on those occasions The Lieu enant Governor President of Council or Commande in theef for the time being is hereby authorized and empower to satisfy the same out of the Public Revenue of the Island by warrant for the amount on the Treasurer of the Island, Provided the said acounts have been previous examined approved and audited in bouncel We it also Orde ed and Ordered by the authority aforesaid that
