WHEREAS An Act passed in the Thirty third year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to provide Returning Officers for Knights, Citizens and Burgesses" to serve in Assembly," was by An Act passed in the last Session of the Legislature, continued to the first day of January in the present year, and that it is necessary further to continue the said Act: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent, of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by Virtue of and under the authority of An Act, passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled "An Act to "repeal certain parts of An Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intitu"led" An Act for making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of

" led " An Act for making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of " Quebec in North America, and to make further Provision for the Government of the faid

of the Thirty third year of His Majesty's Reign, and every part thereof, and every ciause, matter, and thing therein contained, are by the present Act continued until the first day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament.

THEREAS it is expedient further to continue An Act passed in the Thirty sixth year of the Reign of His present-Majesty, inituled, "An Att for making a " temporary Provision for the Regulation of Trade, between this Province and the United " States of America, by Land or by Ihland Navigation," Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty; by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative. Council and Assembly, of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by Virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His " Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for making more effectual Provision for the Government " of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further Provision for the Govern-" ment of the faid Province," And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the faid Act, intituled, " An Act for making a temporary Provision for the Regulation of "Trade, between this Province and the United States of America, by Land or by Inland Naviga-" tion," and all matters and things therein contained, shall continue and be in force, until the first of January, one thousand eight hundred, and from thence to the end of the then next Sellion of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer; Provided always, that all and every order or orders issued and published, under the authority of the aforesaid Act, or which shall be issued or published, under the authority of this Act, shall not continue and be in force, longer than to the said first of January, one thoufand eight hundred, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament.

Provided that the orders &c under that A&, shall continue no longer than the til January 1800.
