### C A P. III.

An Act for the Relief of Perfons holding Lands or immoveable Property of His Majesty, En roture, upon which Lots et Ventes, or Mutation Fines are due.

### (8th April, 1801)

Preamble.

Governor impowered to appoint five Commiffioners for the execution of this Act.

To remove them and appoint others in their flead

Commiffioners and Clerk to take an Oath. III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that the faid Commissioners and Clerk, before they shall be capable of acting in the execution of this Act, shall severally take and subscribe before His Majesty's Chief Justice of this Province, or any two of the Puisne Justices of His Majesty's Court of King's Bench, for the District of Quebec an Oath to the effect following, that is to fay:

The Oath.

**THEREAS** the Collection of the Lots et Ventes now due in the Cenfive of your Majefly's Domaine in this Province, to a certain extent and under certain modifications, is just and expedient, but without limitation would be injurious in particular Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majefty. by and with the cales. advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act paffed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an " Att paffed in, the fourteenth year of His Majefly's Reign, intituled, " An Att for making " more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and " to make further Provision for the Government, of the faid Province," And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, that it fhall and may be lawful to and for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Person administering the Government of this Province. for the time being, by an Inftrum nt or Inftruments under his Hand and Seal at Arms, to nominate and appoint five perfons to be Commissioners for the due execution of this Act, and of the feveral powers and trufts repored under and by virtue thereof; to remove from time to time the faid Commissioners or any of them, and to appoint others, in the place and flead of fuch as shall be removed, or shall die or refign their trust.

II. And be it further, enacted, by the authority aforefaid, that it shall and may be law-

ful to and for the Governor, Ligutenant Governor or Perfon administering the Govern-

ment of this Province for the time being, in like manner, by an Infrument or Infru-

ments under his Hand and Seal at Arms, to nominate and appoint a Clerk, to the aforefaid, Commissioners, and to allow, him fuch reasonable falary as he shall think meet.; and from time to time at his difference, to diffuils and difcharge such Clerk, and to ap-

point another in his place ; and the faid Clerk his hereby enjoined faithfully, to execute

and perform the fervices to be of him required by the faid Commissioners, without demanding or receiving for fuch lervices, any reward or recompence other than such Sala-

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall and may be lawful to and for the faid Commiffioners or any three of them, and they are hereby fully and entirely authorifed and impowered, to accept of and from any perfon or perfons whofoever, fuch pecuniary composition for Lots et Ventes or Mutation Fines, which may be due by fuch perfon or perfons to His Majelty, at the palling of this Act, for any Sale or other Mutation equipolent to the fale of any Lands or Immoveable Property fituate in this Province, and held of His Majefty en Roture, or be payable to His Majefty, and fecured upon any fuch Lands or Immoveable property, in the polleffion of fuch perion or perions, and make fuch relinquifiment and remiffion, upon each of fuch Lots et Ventes or Mutation Fines, as they the faid Commissioners, or any three of them, in their differention, according to the nature and circumftances of each particular cafe, shall deem just and equitable. Provided always, that nothing in this Act contained, fhall authorife and impower, or be confirued to authorife or impower the fail Commitfioners or any of them, to accept of any pecuniary composition or to make any relinquifhment or remission, whatever, in any case or cases of Lands or Immoveable property held of His Majefty, en Reture, upon which only one Lots et Ventes or Mutation Fine is due, or in any cafe or cafes of Sale or of Mutations equipolent to fale of Land, or immoveable Property held of His Majefty en Roture, where any specific lum of money or any part of the price of purchafe, shall have been referved, specifically, by contract, in the hands of the Seller or Purchaser, to pay the Lots et Ventes; those cafes nevertheless excepted, in which such such a furchaser or Seller, shall establish to the fatisfaction of the faid Commissioners or any three of them, that he, she or they, at the time of paffing this Act, were not worth more than four times the amount of the Lots et Ventes, for the payment of which, fuch specific fum as aforefaid or fuch part of the purchase money as alorefaid, fhall have been to referved by him, her or them refpectively.

V. Provided alfoand be it further enacted, that all and every perfon or perfons, who ferved in defence of the City of Quetec, during the blockade thereot, in the year of our Lord one thousand feven hundred and feventy five, and who were then Proprietor or Proprietors of any houfe or houfes, or other buildings in the faid City of Quebec, on which any Lots et Ventes were then due and owing to the Crown, which houfe or houfes or other buildings were deftroyed by fire or otherwife, during the faid Blockade, all and every fuch perfon or perfons, their Widows or heirs, who are now Proprietor or Proprietors of the ground on which such house or houses or other buildings, as aforesaid, were crected, shall be entitled to a full and complete remillion and discharge of fuch Lots et Ventes fo due, which remiffion and difcharge, the faid Commiffioners or any three of them, are hereby authorified and required to grant.

VI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that in all cafes of Land or Immoveable Property, fituate in this Province, and held of His Majefty en Roture, upon which only one Lots et venues or Mutation Fine is due, it shall and may be lawful to and for the Receiver General of this Province, and he is hereby required upon payment If paid within thereof to him, to make thereon the cuftomary abatement of one third: Provided always, that fuch Lots et ventes or Mutation Fine be paid to the faid Receiver General, within twelve Calendar Months, from the palling of this Act, and if the fame be not paid to

If the fame is not paid within that time the whole Lots et Ventes to be recovered withot sy deduc tion.

In all cafes of fales, where any Lots et Venies is due and referved in the hands of the Purchafer or Seller, for which no composition has been accepted the cuftonary abatement to be made.

If paid, within 12 months

If the fame is not paid within that time, the whole Lots et Ventes to be recovered, without any deduction.

In cafes, where Lots et Vestes have been referved in the relation of the Seller &c. the recourfe to be by Perfonal action.

The Commif. fipners to meet in the City of Quebec and impowered to receive and examine the claims of all Perfons for a Remifliou of Lots et Ventes.

And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that in all cafes of Sale or of Mutations, equipolent to fales of Land or Immoveable property held of His Majefty en Roture, where any Lots et ventes or Mutation Fine is due, which hath been referved, specially by contract, in the hands of the Seller or Purchaser, as alorefaid, for which a composition has not been accepted by the faid Commissioners, by virtue of this A&, it shall and may be lawful to and for the Receiver General of this Province, and he is hereby required, upon payment thereof, to him, to make the cuftomary abatement of Provided always, that fuch Lots et ventes fo referved, be paid to the faid Reone third. ceiver General, within twelve Calendar Months, from the passing of this Act, and if the fame be not paid to the faid Receiver General, within twelve Calendar Months from the paffing of this Act. the whole of fuch Lots et ventes or Mutation Fine, fo referved, fhall be due to his Majefly, and fhall and may be recovered wholly and entirely, without any deduction or diminition whatever, any Law, Ulage or Cultom to the contrary notwithstanding. Provided allo, that in all cafes where fuch Lots et ventes or Mutation Fines, have been fo referved in the hands of the Seller or Sellers, the recourse of His Majefly, for the recovery of fuch Lots et ventes, shall be, by perional Action against fuch Seller or Sellers only, without any recourse whatever, against his widow or his heirs, nor against the Lands or immoveable property upon which fuch Lots et Ventes, fo referved, in the hands of fuch Seller, are fecured ; which Lands and immoveable property, from fuch Lots et Vertes fo referved, in the hands of fuch Seller or Sellers, shall, by virtue of this Act, be wholiy free, dilcharged and exonerated, any Law, Statute, Ufage or Cultom to the contrary notwithstanding.

VIII. And for the better execution of this Act, be it further enacted by the authority. aforefaid, that the faid Commiffioners, or any three of them, shall have power to meet and fit from time to time, in fuch place, as they shall find most convenient in the City of Quebec, with or without adjournment, and all perfons shall be at liberty, to deliver their respective claims, for a relinquishment and remission upon any Lots et Ventes or mutation fines, which at the paffing of this Act, fhall by fuch perfons, refpectively, bedue or owing to His Majefty, for any fale or mutation equipolent to the tale of any lands or immoveable property, fituate in this Province, and held of His Majefty en Roture, or be fecured to His Majesty, upon any such Lands or immoveable property, in the possellion of such person or persons, to the faid commissioners, in writing, who shall cause the same to be filed and preferved among their proceedings; and the faid Commissioners, shall also have power, to hear such persons upon their respective claims, by themfelves or by their certain attorney, lawfully appointed, when they or any of them shall require it, to fend their precept or precepts, under their hands and feals, for fuch witneffes, as they the faid Commissioners or any three of them, shall think necesfary to examine, and in like manner, to call before them or any three of them, all officers and other perfons concerned in the management, collection or receipt of cafual and territorial revenue of the crown in this Province, and every and any part thereof, and them the faid witneffes, officers and other perfons, upon the fubject matter of any claim pending

pending before them the faid Commiffioners, to examine upon Oath (which oath they the faid Commiffioners or any three of them are hereby authorifed to administer;) with full power and authority to inspect, peruse and have copies of all and singular papers and records, maps, *Terriers*, accounts and other written Documents, which in any manner or way relate to or concern the faid subject matter of such claims or any of them, in the custody or power of any public officer or office, without payment of any fee or reward whatever, for such inspection, perusal or copies. And if any person or persons who shall be examined upon oath or shall make any affidavit or deposition on oath, touching or concerning the subject matter of any such claim or claims, shall be guilty, of falsely and wilfully swearing to any matter or thing, which if the same had been sworn in any cause or suit in any of His Majesty's courts in this Province, would have amounted to wilful and corrupt perjury, every person fo offending and being thereof convicted, shall incur the same penalties and forfeitures as by the Laws and Statutes of this Province are provided, against persons convicted of wilful and corrupt perjury.

IX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that in all cafes, wherein by virtue of this Act, any pecuniary composition, as aforclaid, thall in manner aforelaid be accepted by the faid Commissioners; it shall and may be lawful to and for the faid Commissioners, or any three of them to allow fuch time for the payment thereof, into the hands of the Receiver General of this Province, as they the faid commissioners, or any three of them, shall see fit; and in all cases whatever. by virtue of this Act, wherein a pecunia: y composition as aforefaid shall in manner aforefaid be accepted by the faid Commillioners, a certificate there of shall be granted by the faid Commissioners, or any three of them, which shall be expressed in the words following, or as near thereto as may be, that is to fay, By the commillioners appointed by the Act of the Provincial Parliament, intituled, " An Act for the Relief of perfons holding lands or immoveable property of His Majely en Roture upon which Lots et " Ventes or mutation fines are due", " Thefe are to certify, that the faid Commissioners have " agreed on the part of His Majelly to accept from A. B. as and for a composition for all " Lots et Ventes due and owing at the time of paffing the faid Act, by the faid A. B. to His "" " Majelly in confequence of,' (here enumerate the different fales or Acts equipolent to fales, upon which the Lots et Ventes for which the composition is accepted, have arisen, and briefly defcribe the property fold) "the fum of \_\_\_\_\_ current money of this " Province, to be paid by the laid A. Perfons convicted of Forging counterfeiting &c.the certificate or receipt &c. guilty of Felonys faid fubscription or indorfement, and the faid certificate and subscription or indorfement fhall in manner aforefaid, be executed double, and one fuch certificate with fuch fubleription or indorfement, executed as aforefaid, shall be delivered to the perfon or perfons in whole favor luch certificate shall be given, and the other certificate, with fuch fubscription or indorfement executed as aforfaid, shall be kept by the faid Commiffioners and fhall be filed and preferved among their proceedings; and upon payment of the fum of money in the faid certificate mentioned in the time therein mentioned to the Receiver General of this Province, the faid Receiver General at the foot or on the back of fuch certificate, shall subscribe or indorfe a receipt therefor, which fhall be in the words and figures following, or as near thereto as may be, that is to fay, " Received the-—dav of— -----of and from A. B. above (cr within). " named, the fum of--Current money, of the Province of Lower Canada, being " the composition money expressed in the above (or within) written certificate," figned E. F. Receiver General : which laid receipt thall be also figned in the prefence of two lawful witneffes; and fuch certificate and receipt, shall be entered at length of record by the faid Receiver General in a book by him for that purpole to be kept, and fuch certificate and receipt being fo executed by the faid Commissioners, and by the faid perfon or perions, and fo entered of record, by the faid Receiver General, shall effectually free exonerate and discharge, as well the faid person, or persons to whom the faid certificate and receipt shall be fo given and granted, as the lands or other immoveable property held en Roture of His Majefty, and to which the faid certificate shall relate, of and from all, each and every the Lots et Ventes or mutation fines due or owing to His Majelty, upon the feveral fales, or Acts equipolent to fales, enumerated in fuch Certificate, and neither fuch Perfon or Perfons whofoever, nor fuch Lands or Immoveable Property, shall at any time afterwards, be liable to or called upon, fued, troubled, molefled or queflioned for or in respect of such Lots et Venies or Mutation Fines, or any or either of them, or any part thereof; Provided always nevertheles, that if the sum of money in such Certificate mentioned, fhall not be paid to the faid Receiver General, within the time therein limited, the faid Certificate from and after the day therein limited for the payment of the fum of money, therein mentioned, shall be abfolutely null and void, to all intents and purposes what loever, as if the fame had never been made, and all and each and every the Lots et Ventes, upon the leveral Sales or Acts equipolent to Sales, in the faid Certificate mentioned, shall be due to His Majesty, and shall and may be recovered wholly and entirely, without any deduction or diminution whatfoever, any Law, Ufage or Cuftom to the contrary notwithstanding.

X. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that if any Perfon or Perfons, fhall fallely make, forge or counterfeit, or caufe or procure to be falfely made, forged or counterfeited or willingly or knowingly act or affitt in the falfe making, forging or counterfeiting, of any fuch Certificate or Receipt, as aferefaid, or fhall counterfeit the Signature or Signatures of the faid Commiffioners or of any or either of them, or of the Receiver General of this Province for the time being, to any fuch Certificate or Receipt, or fhall alter or erate any authentic Certificate or Receipt, made and executed by the faid Commiffioners or by the faid Receiver General, refpectively, or fhall utter or publifh, as true, any fuch falfe, forged, counterfeited, altered or erafed Certificate or Receipt, knowing the fame to be falfe, forged, counterfeited, altered or erafed ; all and every fuch Perfon or Perfons being thereof in due form of Law convicted, in either C. 3-4. either of His Majesty's Courts of King's Bench in this Province, shall be adjudged guilty of Felony.

Powers of the Committione ralimited to one year.

Wonies recoverced under this Act, how to be accounted for.

XI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that the Powers hereby vested in the faid Commissioners, shall continue and be in force for the term of one year, from the day on which this Act shall receive His Majesty's Royal Affent, and that at the expiration of the faid period of one year. the proceedings of the faid Commissioners and all Papers thereunto relating in their possession and custody, shall by them be delivered in the Office of the Clerk of the Papier Terrier of the King's Domaine in this Province, there to remain for ever of Record.

XII. And be it further enacted by the authority afore aid, that all fuch monies as fhall be collected by virtue of this Act, fhall be accounted for to His Majefty, through the Commissioners of His Majefty's Treasury for the time being, in such manner and form, as His Majefty shall direct.

## C A P. IV.

An Act to explain and amend the Law respecting Last Wills and Testaments.

### (8th April, 1801)

Freamble.

Claufe in Act 24 Geo. III. recited.

Perfons having the legal exercise of their Rights, may devise or bequeath by last will and testament their Estates &c.

'HEREAS by the Act of the Fourteenth year of His Majefty's Reign, intituled, " An Att for making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of " Quebec in North America," it is enacted, that every owner of Lands, Goods or Credits in the faid Province, who has a right to alienate the faid Lands, Goods, or Credits in his or her life time, by Deed of Sale, Gift or otherwife, may devife or bequeath the fame at his or her Death, by his or her Laft Will and Teftament, any Law, Ulage or Cuftom, heretofore or now prevailing in the faid Province to the contrary hereof in any wife notwithstanding, fuch Will being executed, either according to the Laws of Canada, or according to the forms prefcribed by the Laws of England. And Whereas doubts and difficulties have arifen in this Province, touching the true intent and meaning of the faid Act, in this respect: Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majefty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legiflative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act, paffed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An AEt to repeal certain parts of an AEt paffed in the fourteenth year of His Majefty's Reign, " intituled, " An AEt for making more effectual provision for the Government of the. Province " of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the faid " Province," And it is hereby enacted by the Authority of the fame, that it shall and may be lawful, for all and every Perfon or Perfons, of found intellect and of age, having the legal exercise of their rights, to devise or bequeath by Last Will and Testament, whether the same be made by a Husband or Wife, in favor of each other, or in favor of one or more of their Children, as they shall see meet, or in favor of any other Perion or Perions whatfoever, all and every his or her Lande, Goods or Credits. whatever be the tenure of fuch Lands, and whether they be, Propres, Acquets or Conquets.
