## C A P. IX.

An Act to continue for á limited time and amend an ACt paffed in the thirty ninth year of His Majefty's Reign, intituled, "An ACt for granting '. further encouragement, and a more ample allowance to the Maitres and Aides de Pofte, in this Province."
(5th April, 1802.)
Whereas an Aat was paffed by thè Legiflature of this Province, in the thirty ninth year of His Majefty's Reign, intituled, "An Att for granting further en"couragement and a more ample allowance to the Maitres and Aides de Pofte in this Pro"vince," which Act is to have continuance until the end of the prefent Seffion of the Provincial Legillature, and whereas it is expedient that it be continued and amended as herein after mentioned, Be it therefore enacted by the King's moft Excellent Majefly, by and with the advice and confent of the Legiflative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conftituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act paffed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to ". repeal certain parts of an Act paffed in the fourteenth year of His Majefy's Reign; intituled, "An AIt for making more effectual Provifon for the Government of the Province "s of Qubec, in Narth America, and to make further Provifion for the Government of " 6 the faid Province," And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, that the faid Act, intituled, An Att for granting further encouragement and a more ampile allowance "for the Maitres and Aides de Pofte in this Province," and all matters and things therein contained, fhall continue to be in force, until the firt day of January one thoufand eight hundied and three, and from thence to the end of the then next Seffion of the Provincial Pariament and no longer.
II. And whereas great inconvenience hath arifen from the Maitres de Pofte and their Aides, driving horfes without fufficient harnefs, and more particularly, (when two horfes are required) by driving the faid horfes with reins only to one of the fame. It is therefore snacted by the authority aforefaid, that no Maitre de Pofe or Aide de Pofte, fhall be entited to demand or receive any fare or hire, for any carriage or horfes when
when he or they may drive two horfes, without good and fufficient reins to each of the horfes harneffed to any carriage of what nature foever.

Be it therefore enaEted by the King's moft Excellent Majelly, by and with the advice and confent of the Legifative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conftituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal * certain parts of an ACt paffed in the fourteenth year of His Majefty's Reign, inti"tuled, "An AEt for making more effectual Provizion for the Government of the Provinco " of Quebec in Norih America;" and to make further Provifion for the Government of " the faid Province," and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, that the faid AEt intituled, "An AEt for the relief of Perfons hoiding Lands or Immoveable Proper"ty of His Majefly en Rôture upon which Lots ot Ventes or Mutation Fines are due," and all matters and things therein contained, fhall continue and be in force until the eighth day of July, which will be in this prefent year of our Lord, one thoufand eight hundred and two, and no longer, any thing contained in the faid Act to the contrary notwathflanding.
