## MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,

INTHEREAS the fum of Three Hundred and Eighty Three Pounds, Four Prcamble. Shillings and Eleven Pence, current money of this Province, by Your Majefty's Orders has been iffued and advanced to the Commissioners appointed by virtue of and under the authority of an Act paffed in the thirty ninth year of Your Majefty's Reign, intituled, " An Act to provide Houfes of Correction in the feveral 39 Geo. III. cap. " Districts of this Province." And Whereas the further sum of Six Hundred and Fifteen Pounds, Thirteen Shillings and two Pence, hath also by Your Majefty's Orders been iffued to Edward William Gray, Isaac Winflow Clarke and Louis Guy, Esquires, for repairing the injury done to the common Gaol of the Diftrict of Montreal, by Fire; May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of " an Act paffed in the fourteenth year of his Majefty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for \*\* making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North. " his Majesty, certain new Duties on the importation into this Province of all ma-" nufactured Tobacco and Snuff, and for difallowing the Drawback on Tobacco " manufactured within this Province," and now remaining in the hands of the Receiver General of this Province, unappropriated, there shall be issued and applied, the fum of nine hundred and ninety eight Pounds, eighteen Shillings and one penny, current money of this Province, to make good the like fums which have, fo as aforefaid, been iffued and advanced by his Majefty's orders.

Sums applicable by Law to fupport Houles of Correction may be applied in fuch proportions as the Governor may think expedient.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that the fums applicable by Law to support Houles of Correction in the Districts of Quebec, Montreal, and Three Rivers, respectively, may be applied to any or either of fuch House or Houfes of Correction, in fuch proportions as shall appear expedient to the Governor. Lieutenant Governor or perfon administering the Government, for the time being.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforelaid, that the due application of the faid fum of money, pursuant to the directions of this Act, shall be accounted for to his Majefty, his Heirs and Succeffors, though the Lords Commiffioners of his Majefty's Treafury, in fuch manner and form, as his Majefty. his Heirs and Succeffors shall direct.
