“ Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of *Great Britain and Ireland*, KING,  
“ Defender of the Faith.”

C A P. I.

AN ACT further to continue, for a limited time, an Act passed in the  
Forty-third year of his Majesty’s Reign, intituled, “ *An Act for the*  
“ *better preservation of his Majesty’s Government, as by Law happily esta-*  
“ *blished in this Province.*”

(19th. April 1806 )

Preamble.

WHEREAS an Act was passed by the Legislature of this Province in the forty  
third year of his Majesty’s Reign, intituled, “ *An Act for the better preser-*  
“ *vation*”

“*vation of his Majesty's Government as by Law happily established in this Province,*” which Act was to have continuance only until the end of the present Session of the Provincial Parliament. And whereas it is expedient that the said Act should be further continued: Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, “*An Act*”  
 “*to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of his Majesty's*”  
 “*Reign, intituled, “An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government*”

“*of the Province of Quebec in North America,*” and to make further provision for  
 “*the Government of the said Province;*” and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said Act and all matters and things therein contained, shall continue to be in force until the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and seven, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament. Provided always, that after the close of the present war, all and every person or persons committed under the authority of the said Act, shall have the benefit and advantage of the laws relating to or providing for the liberty of the subject, in this Province.

Provided that at the end of the present war persons detained by virtue of this Act, shall have the advantages of the Laws providing for the liberty of the subject.
