C A P. VII.

An Act to provide for an omiffion respecting the Common of the Town or Borough of Three Rivers.

(19th. April, 1806.)

Preamble.

Act 41 Geo. III. cap. 11, recited.

WHEREAS in and by an Act made and passed in the forty first year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, " An AEt for the better regula-" ting the Common belonging to the Town of Three Rivers." it was amongst other things enacted, that " it thall and may be lawful for the inhabitants of the laid " Town or Borough of Three Rivers, to affemble and meet on the first Monday in " the Month of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and " five, at fuch hour and place, as shall by notice given ten days before in writing, " posted up at the doors of the different Churches in the faid Town or Borough, " be fixed on, for the choice and appointment of a Chairman and four Trustees " of the aforefaid Common, to fucceed the Chairmain and Truftees who fhall " have gone out of office, and that the inhabitants of the faid Town or Borough " then prefent and qualified as in the faid Act mentioned, shall and may at such " time and place, choose and appoint as in and by the faid Act is directed a Chair-" man and four Truftees of the aforefaid Common, who shall continue in Office to " the first Monday of April, which will be in the fourth next succeeding year, 66 and that a perfon appointed by His Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant Go-" vernor or perfon administering the Government of this Province for the time " being, shall prefide at fuch Affembly or meeting, and declare by writing un-" der his hand and feal, who are the perions choien and appointed to the of-" fice of Chairman and Truftees of the faid Common for the four next fucceed-" ing years." And whereas the faid affemb'y and meeting of the faid inhabitants of the faid Town or Borough of Three Rivers, was not held upon the faid first Monday of April in the faid year one thousand eight hundred and five, as in and by the faid Act is directed: Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conftituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act paffed in the fourteenth " year of His Majefty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for making more effectual Provision

Governor to appoint a perfon to prefide at the affembly.

His duty.

" Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America," and " to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province," and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that it shall and may be lawful for the inhabitants of the aforefaid Town or Borough of Three Rivers, to affemble and meet on the first Monday in the month of June next, at fuch hour and place, as thall by notice given ten days before in writing, posted up at the doors of the different Churches in the faid Town or Borough be fixed on, for the choice and appointment of a Chairman and four Truftees of the aforefaid Common, belonging to the Town of Three Rivers, to fucceed the Chairman and Truftees appointed under and by virtue of the faid Act, intituled, " An Act for better regulating " the Common belonging the Town of Three Rivers," who have gone out of office ; and that the faid inhabitants of the faid Town or Borough of Three Rivers, then present and qualified, as in the faid A& last mentioned is provided, shall and may on the faid first Monday in June next, choole and appoint, as in the faid Act last mentioned is directed, a Chairman and four Truftees of the aforefaid Common who shall continue in office until the first Monday in April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine, in like manner to all intents and purpofes whatever, as if the fuch Chairman and Truftees had under and by virtue of the faid last mentioned Act, been unto the faid offices appointed, upon the first Monday in April which was in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five : Provided always, that a perfon appointed by his Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or perfon administering the government of this province for the time being, shall prefide at the affembly and meeting in and by this Act appointed and authorifed, and shall declare by writing under his hand and fest who are the perfons chosen and appointed to the Office of Chairman and Truftees of the faid Common, under and by virtue of this Act, in like manner to all intents and purposes, as if such affembly and meeting had been held under and by virtue of the faid Act, intituled, " An Act for better regulating the Com-" mon belonging to the Town of Three Rivers," upon the first Monday in April. which was in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five.
