CAP. XIV.

AN ACT to continue for a limited time, An Act passed in the thirty sixth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for making a tem"porary provision for the regulation of Trade between this Prevince, and the United States of America, by Land or Inland Navigation.

(14th. April, 1808.)

Preamble.

[THEREAS it is expedient further to continue an AC passed in the thirty sixth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, " An Ast for making a temporary prouission for the regulation of Trade betweenthis Province, and the United States of " America by Land or by Inland Navigation." Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the sourteenth year " of His Majesty's reign" intituled, " An Act for making more effectual provision " furthe Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America" " and to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province," and it is hereby enacted, by the authority of the same, that the said Act, intituled, " An Act for making a temso porary provision for the regulation of Trade, between this Province, and the United States of America, by Land or by Inland Navigation," and all matters and things therein contained, shall continue and be in force, until the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and nine, and from thence to the then next Seffion: of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer. Provided always, that all and everyorder or orders issued and published under the authority of the aforesaid Act, or which shall be issued or published under the authority of this Act, shall not continue and be in force longer than to the faid first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and nine, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincials Parliament.
