C A P. XVIII.

AN ACT to continue, for a limited time, an Act passed in the fortieth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to give further powers to "the Executive Government to prevent the introduction or spreading of infectious or contagious diseases in this Province."

(14th. April, 1808.)

Freamble.

HEREAS an Act was passed by the Legislature of this Province, in the fortieth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act to give further powers to the Executive Government to prevent the introduction or spreading of infectious " or contagious difeafes in this Province," which Act is to have continuance only unto the end of the present Session of the Legislature; And Whereas it is expedient and necessary further to continue the said Act. Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act, passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled at An Ast for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America," and to make further or provision for the Government of the faid Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said Act, intituled, " An Act to give further of powers to the Executive Government to prevent the introduction or fpreading of in-" fectious or contagious diseases in this Province;" and all matters and things therein contained, shall continue, and be in force, until we first day of January, in the year of our Lord One Thouland, Eight hundred and Twelve, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament and notionger.
