TATHEREAS an Act was passed by the Legislature of this Province, in the fony third year of his Majesty's reign, intituled, " An Ad for the better preservation of his Majesty's Government, as by law happily established in this Province;" which Act was to have continuance only until the end of the present Session of the Provincial Parliament; And whereas it is expedient, that the faid Act should be: further continued; Be it therefore enacted, by the King's most excellent Majesty, by and with the advice, and confent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and affembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act " to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the sourt enth year of his Majesty's " reign," initialed, " An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America, and to make further provision for the "Government of the faid Province; and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the laid Act, and all matters and things therein contained, shall continue to be in force, until the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and nine,
