AN ACT to correct an accidental Error in the Act therein mentioned for the relief of Infane Perfons and others.

(15th May, 1809.)

Preamble.

Claufe in Act 48 Geo. 111. cap 2. recited in part.

7 HEREAS an Act was passed in the forty eighth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for applying a certain fum therein mentioned to make good " a like fum iffued and advanced in purfuance of an Addrefs of the Houfe of Affembly, " and for the relief of Infane perfons and for the fupport of Foundlings," wherein among other things, it was enacted, " That from and after the first day of April " next, (thereby meaning and intending the first day of April, one thousand eight " hundred and eight,) it should be lawful to and for the Governor, Lieutenant " Governor or Perlon administering the Government of this Province for the time " being, out of any unappropriated monies in the hands, or which may come into " the hands of the Receiver General of this Province, ariting under all, or any " of the Acts of the Provincial Parliament, to apply and appropriate a fum not " exceeding twelve hundred Pounds per annum, towards the relief and support of " fuch unfortunate perlons as may, from derangement of intellect, be incapable " of earning their fuftenance and towards the maintenance of fuch new born infants " as may be inhumanly exposed or deferted and require protection, as also towards " the relief of fick and infirm perfons, and towards the aid and support of fuch " religious Communities as receive and administer relief to perfons of the above " descriptions." And whereas the above in part recited Act did not receive the Roval Alfent until the fourteenth day of April one thousand eight hundred and eight, whereby in its literal construction, it could only take effect on the first day of April one thousand eight hundred and nine, thereby leaving the unfortunate objects for whole relief it was defigned a whole year, without any provision, contrary
