## CAP. V.

An Act further to continue the Acts therein mentioned for making a temporary Provision for the Regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of America, by land or inland Navigation.

(10th May, 1812.)

THEREAS An Act was passed in the thirty-sixth year of his Majesly's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making a temporary Provision for the "Regulation of trade between this Province and the United States of America by " land or Inland Navigation, which Act was continued and amended by another act: " passed in the forty-eighth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to con-"tinue for a limited time, "An Act passed in the thirty-sixth year of His Majesty's "Reign, intituled, "An Act for making a temporary provision for the Regulation " of Trade between this Province and the United States of America, by land or " inland Navigation," and whereas it is expedient further to continue the faid two Acts; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal " certain parts of an Act passed in the sourteenth Year of His Majesty's Reign, " intituled, " An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of 4 the Province of Quebec in North America; and to make further provision for " the Government of the faid Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said Act, intituled, " An Act for making a temporary pro-" Provision for the Regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of America, by land or inland Navigation;" and also the said Act, intituled, 66 An Act to continue, for a limited time, an Act passed in the Thirty-fixth Year of 46 His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making a temporary provision for the Regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of America by 66 land or inland Navigation," and all matters and things in the faid Acts contained shall continue to be in force, until the first day of June, One thousand eight hundred and thirteen, and no longer.

This Act may be altered.

II. And be it further enacted, by the authority aforesaid, that this Act may be altered, amended or repealed by any Act or Acts to be made in this present. Session of the Legislature.
