CAP. X.

An Act to grant a further Sum of Money, for the more effectual attainment of the purposes of the Act of the Fifty-first year of His Majesty's Reign, which provides for the Relief of Infane Persons and the supports of Foundlings, and others therein mentioned.

(17th March, 1814.)

Preamble.

THEREAS the Sum of Fifteen Hundred Pounds appropriated by the Act of the Fifty-fielt Year of His Majesty's Reign, Chapter the Fifteenth, for the Relief of Infane Persons and the Support of Foundlings, and others therein mentioned, has proved insufficient, and that it is expedient and necessary to apply a further sum of Money, to the more effectual attainment of the purposes of the faid Act, and Whereas it is expedient to fix and determine the proportions of the funs of money to be granted for each of the Districts, of Quebec, Montreal, and Three Rivers. Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majelly, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act: to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the Fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for making more effectival provision for the Government: of the Province of Quebec in North. America," and to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the passing of this Act, it shall and may be lawful to and for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Perlon administering the Government of this Province, for the time being, out of the unappropriated monies. which now are in or hereafter may come into the hands of the Receiver General of this Province, ariting from any Act or Acts of the Provincial Parliament, powered to grant together with the aforciard for of Fifteen Hundred Pounds, to apply a further fum not exceeding Nine Hundred Pounds, current money of this Province, ansum of money, nually, to the purpoles of the aforelaid Act, of the Esfty lirst year of His Majesty's.

Continuance of this Act.

11. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that it shall and mayor be lawful to and for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering the Government of the faid Province, for the time being, to apply both the faid fems, to the extent of Fourteen Hundred Pounds for the Datrict of Quebec, of Seven Hundred Pound- for the District of Montreal, and of Three Hundred Pounds. for the District of Three Rivers, to the attainment and promotion of the purposes, of the aforesaid Act, of the Fifty-fielt year of His Majesty's Reign. always, that this Act shall continue and be in force, until the first day of April, One Thousand eight hundred and fifteen, and no longer.
