have been purchifed, a deduction of eight pence upon every minot of Salt form after-fail touchiled, any Law, Utage or Custom to the contrary, in any wife not-withflanning.

No recovery or deduction nitowall upon safe between a certain period, and only of crose persons who have received, a certain safe imported or said by them.

VI Provided always, and it is hereby enacted, that no such recovery or deduction aforefaid, that he had and allowed, except upon Salt purchased herween, the first day of May in the present year of our Lord, and against those persons only who under and by virtue of this Act, have been allowed or received the said sum of eight pence upon every minot of Salt by thems imported and soid as aforesaid.

CAP'IX.

An Act for applying a further Sum of Money, towards the erecting as Common Gaol, with a Court Hall, at New-Carlille, in the inferior District of Gaspé.

(17th Murch, 1814)

HEREAS the Sum already appropriated by law, for the purpose of erecting a Common Gaol with a Court Hall, at New Cathfle in the inf rior D thrick of Gaspé, le's been lound insufficient, and that it appears expedient to apply a firether Sum of money, for the erecling and completing the faid Common Gaot, with a Court Hall, and the appendages thereof, may it therefore pleafe Your Majesty that it may be en ded, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act paffed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled; "An Act to-" repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the Fourteenth Year of His Majesty's " Reign, intituled, " An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government " of the Province of Quebec in North America," And to make further provision for " the Government of the faid Province;" and it is hereby enasted by the authority of the same, that it shall and may be lawful for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or the Person administering the Government, for the time being, by Warrant or Wartants, under his Hand and Seal, directed to the Receiver General of this Province, to iffue to the Commissioners or any two of them appointed or who may hereafter be appointed, for the erecting the laid Common Gaol with a Court Half at New Carlifle aforelaid, by virtue of and under the under the authority of an Act paffed in the Forty-eighth year of Your Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act " for erecting Common Gaols with Court Halls in the Inferior District of Gaspé," a further Sum of Money not exceeding ili the whole, One Thousand one hundred Pounds, current money of this Province, out of any unappropriated monies which now are or hereafter may be in the hands of the faid Receiver General to be applied towards

A sum of money not exceeding: £1100 granted, for completing the common ganl; and court hall, at timpé.

towards the building and completing of the faid Common Gaol and Court Hall and the Appendages thereof.

And £20 allowed to the Treasurer and Clerk, II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall and may be lawful for His Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering the Government, for the time being, to make to the Treasurer and Clerk-who may be appointed, under and by the authority of the aforesaid Act, to the Commissioners for the crecking of the aforesaid Common Gaol, with a Court Hall, at New-Carlise aforesaid, a further allowance for his time, services and contingent Expences, not exceeding in the whole, the sum of Twenty pounds, current money of this Province, out of the sum granted in and by the present Act.

Commissioners to account for, the money advanced to them, by, this Acta

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that the faid Commissioners for the erecting of the faid Common Gaol, with a Court Hall, at New-Carlise aforefaid, when thereunto required shall account to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering the Government of this Province, for the time being, for the application and expenditure of all and every the sum and sums of money, to be advanced to them, in conformity to this Act, in such manner and form as the Governor, Lieutenant Governor or Person administering the Government of this Province, for the time being, shall appoint and direct.

Application of the monics to be accounted for, to His Majesty. IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that due application of the said monies, pursuant to the directions of this Act, shall be accounted for to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in such manner and form as His Majesty shall direct.

V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the aforesaid Act, made and passed in the forty-eighth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for erecting Common Gaols, with Court Halls, in the Inserior District of Gaspé," and every Clause, matter and thing therein contained, in so far as the same is not altered by this Act, shall be and continue in sorce, the same as if this Act had never been made.
