"A T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the Twentyfirst day of January, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, in the fifty fifth year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith. And from thence continued by feveral Prorogations to the Twenty-fixth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fixteen.

" Being the Second Seffion of the Eighth Provincial Parliament of Lower-" Canada.

An A& to continue, for a limited time, an A& paffed in the Forty-eighth year of His Majefty's Reign, intituled "An A& to regulate the Trial "of Controverted Elections or Returns of Members to ferve in the "House of Assembly of Lower Canada."

(26th. February, 1816.)

W HEREAS an Act was passed in the Forty-eighth year of His Majesty's reign intituled "An Act to regulate the Trial of Controverted Elections or re-" turns of Members to ferve in the House of Assembly of Lower Canada," which faid Act was continued by an Act passed in the Fisty-fourth year of His Majesty's Reign until the first day of May, One thousand eight hundred and Sixteen

fixteen; and no longer; And whereas it is expedient further to continue the faid Act paffed in the Forty eighth year of His Majefty's Reign; Be it therefore enacted by the King's moft Excellent Majefty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legifictive Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act "paffed in the fourteenth year of His Majefty's Reign", intituled, "An Act for "making more effectual provision for the Government of the Prevince of Quebec "in North America," and to make further provision for the Government of the "faid Province." And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, that "the faid Act, initialed "An Act to regulate the Trial of Controverted Elections or Returns of Members to ferve in the Houfe of Affembly of Lower Cana-"da," and all matters and things therein contained, fhall continue and be in force until the firft day of May, One thousand eight hundred and twenty, and no longer.
