WHEREAS Your Majefty's Representative in this Province, the Governor in Chief thereof, hath, by a Meffage to both Houses of the Provincial Parliament, in the present Seffion of the same, been graciously pleased to fignify that it is expedient to augment the Salary of His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of this Province, to enable him to live in this Province, in a manner becoming the flation he holds, and that a furtable refidence be found for him; We, Your Majefly's most dutiful and loyal subjects the Commons of Your Majefty's Province of Lower-Canada in Provincial Parliament affembled, most humbly beseech Your Majefty, that it may be enacted, and be it enaced by the King's most Excellent Majefty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act paffed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, initialed, "An Act to repeal cer-" tain parts of an Act paffed in the fourteenth year of His Majefty's reign, initialed,

£2,500 sterling per annum granted to the Lieutonant Governor, and £500 more for House Rent, during his residence in this Province.

" the faid Province;" And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, that out of the unappropriated monies which now are, or that hereafter may come into the hands of His Majefty's Receiver-General in this Province, the fam of Two thoufand five hundred Pounds, fterling, fhall be annually appropriated and paid by Warrant or Warrants to His Excellency SIR FRANCIS NATHANISL BURTON, the Lieutenant-Governor, during his refidence in this Province, in lieu of his prefent Salary, and that a further fum at the rate of Five hundred Pounds, currency, per annum, fhall, out of the funds aforefaid, be alfo appropriated and charged against the fame to defray the expense incurred in providing a furnished house for the refi-

dence of the Lieutenant-Governor aforefaid, from the month of Júly laft, to the first day of May next, and alfo, that from and after the first day of May next, a further fum of Five hundred Pounds, currency, per annum, for the purpose of providing a furnished house for the accommodation of His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor aforefaid, during his refidence in this Province, shall in like manner be, and the same is hereby appropriated, and shall annually be paid out of the Funds aforefaid.

Expenditure of the money to be accounted for to His Majesty.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that the due application of the monies to be paid in virtue of this Act, fhall be accounted for to His Majefty, his Heirs and Succeffors, through the Lords Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treafury, for the time being, in fuch manner and form, as His Majefty, his Heirs and Succeffors fhall be pleafed to direct.

CAP. IV.

An Act to appropriate certain fums of Money therein mehtioned towards opening and repairing a Road from Drummondville to Sorel and the Timiscouata Road, and for other purpofes.
