Preamble.

TATHEREAS it is expedient further to continue, for a limited time, an Act passed in the sifty-eighth year of the Reign of His Majesty George the Third, intituled, "An Act to provide more effectually for the security of the Cities of 66 Quebec and Montreal, and for establishing a Watch and Night Lights in the " laid Cities, and for other purpoles," the duration whereof, by an Act passed in the first year of the Reign of His present Majesty, Chapter eleventh, hath been extended and is also thereby limited to the first day of May, one thousand, eight hundred and twenty-three; Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the sourteenth year of His Ma-" jesty's reign, intituled, " An Att for making more effectual provision for the Go-" vernment of the Province of Quebec in North-America," and to make further provis fion for the Government of the said Province; And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said Act passed in the fifty-eighth year of the Reign of His late Majesty George the Third, intituled, "An Act to provide more effectually for the security of the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, by establishing a Watch " and Night Lights in the faid Cities, and for other purpoles"; shall further continue to be and remain in force, and all and every the duties by the faid Act imposed, shall be raised, levied and collected and paid as therein-mentioned and provided, and all and every the clauses, matters and things in the said Act mentioned and contained, shall also further continue to be and remain in full force and effect, until the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, and no longer.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that this, as well as the Act 58th Geo. 3, eap. 2, and this Act, may be re-pealed during the above-mentioned Act, passed in the sisty-eighth year of His late Majesty's Reign, may be altered, amended or repealed, by an Act or Acts of the Legislature of this Province, if need be, during the present Session of the same.
