An Act to provide further Regulation concerning the Infpection and Packing of Beef and Pork, intended for Exportation.

(22d March, 1823.)

XTHEREAS it is expedient to make further provision with respect to the curing, packing and Infpection of Beef and Pork to be exported from this Province. than hath heretofore been made ; Be it therefore enacted by the King's Moft Excellent Majelty, by and with the advice and confent of the Legiflative Council and Affembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, conflituted and allembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act paffed in the fourteenth year of His Ma-" jefty's reign, intituled, " An Att for making more effectual provision for the Go-" vernment of the Province of Quebec in North-America," and to make further provi-" fion for the Government of the faid Province"; And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, that from and after the thirty-first day of December next, After the sist of every barrel in which beef or pork shall be packed or repacked for exportation from After the sist of every barret in which beer of poix mail be packed of repacked for exportation from barrels is which Beef and Pork fhall be of the contents aforefaid as nearly as can be, nor fhall any falted or pickled packed or re-portation, to be of portation, to be of certain dimense cafks exceeding in contents the quantity of callons above foreifed under the cafks exceeding in contents the quantity of gallons above fpecified, under the penalty of leizure and forfeiture, as provided in the seventeenth section of an AG passed in the forty-fourth year of the reign of His late Majesty, George the Third, intituled, " An Act to regulate the curing, packing and Infpection of Beef and " Pork to be exported from the Province of Lower-Canada,"

Bung holes in future to be made on the sides of the barrels, and the pressing or pack-ing to be done with a screw.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that the bung holes which it may be neceffary to make in barrels containing falted Beef or Pork intended for exportation, purfuant to this Act, shall, instead of being made in the head of the barrel as heretofore, be made on the fide or bilge thereof, and that the packing or preffing of the meat inftead of being done as heretofore, shall be done with a fcrew for the purpole. ____IIL

Not however, to exceed 75 lbs. in each barrel.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid that the quantity of falt which each barrel of fuch Beef or Pork intended for exportation as aforefaid fhall contain, fhall be left to the judgment of the Infpector of Beef and Pork infpecting the fame, any thing in the above-mentioned Act, paffed in the forty-fourth year of His late Majefty's Reign, notwithftanding; Provided neverthelefs, that fuch quantity of falt, fhall, not in any cafe exceed feventy-five pounds weight in any one barrel.

Inspectors of Beef and Pork entitled to a remuneration for storage,

IV. And whereas it is requifite for the facility of trade to authorize the Infpectors of Beef and Pork to provide fufficient Warehouses or Stores for the reception and deposit of such Beef and Pork as they may be required to inspect and repack, and that a certain reasonable rate of Storage shall be allowed upon each and every barrel that may remain in their respective Warehouses or Stores beyond a certain time : Be it therefore further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that from and after the paffing of this ACt it shall be lawful for the Inspectors of Beef and Pork in either of the Cities of Quebec or Montreal, appointed under and in virtue of the aforefaid A& paffed in the forty-fourth year of His late Majefty's Reign, chapter ninth, on providing themselves with good and sufficient Warehouses or Stores for receiving and repacking fuch Beef and Pork as may be brought or delivered to them for infpection and examination, to charge and demand as florage upon each and every barrel for and at the rate of three pence, currency, for the first month, and two pence, currency, for every subsequent month, which the same may remain in such Warehouse or Store, after the expiration of eight days from the day on which they may have been inspected and examined.

Continuance of this Ast.

V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall continue to be in force until the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-fix, and no longer.
