1 George IV - Chapter 13

An Act to continue for a limited time two certain Acts therein-mentioned, relating to Houses of Correction in the several Districts in this Province. (17th March, 1821.)

Whereas it is expedient to for a limited time, an Act passed in the fifty-seventh year of the Reign of His late Majesty George the Third, intituled, "An Act to provide temporary Houses of Correction in the several Districts of this province," as amended by an Act passed in the fifty-eight year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to amend an Act passed in the fifty-seventh year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An Act to provide temporary Houses of Correction in the several Districts of this Province, and for other purposes," Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America,' and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the above recited Act passed in the fifty-seventh year of His late Majesty's Reign, as amended by the said Act passed in the fifty-eighth year of His late Majesty's Reign, and all and every the matters and things in the said acts respectively mentioned and contained, and all and every the sums of money therein-mentioned and appropriated, shall annually, during this Act, be advanced and paid for the purposes of the said acts, and the proportions therein specified, and shall be accounted for as in and by the said Acts it is mentioned and provided.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the above recited Acts, passed in the fifty-seventh and fifty-eighth years of His late Majesty's Reign, shall be and remain in full force and effect until the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-three and no longer.
