## An ACT for establishing a TENDER in all PAYMENTS to be made in this Province.

WHEREAS it is neceffary for the afcertaining of contratts, pramize. to determine the value of the coin in which all tenders may be lawfully made.

## CAP.XVII

## An ACT for establishing the RATE of INTEREST.

## 1. Be it enacted by the Gsvernor, Council and Afembly,

THAT no perfon or perfons whatfoever, upon any contract which may be made, thall directly or indirectly accept or receive for loan of any monies, wares, merchandize, or other commodities whatfoever, above the value of $/ 2 x$ pounds for the forbearance of one bundred pounds for the term of one year, and fo after that rate for a greater or lefs fum, or for a longer or fhorter time; and that all bonds, contracts, obligations and affirances whatfoever, for payment of any principal, or money, to be lent, or covenanted to be performed, whereupon, or whereby there fhall be referved, taken, or received above the rate of $/ / \mathrm{ix}$ pounds for one bundred pomads as aforefaid, thall be utterly void; and that all and every perfon, or perfons whatfoever, who fhall, upon any contract, bond, obligation or aflurance to be made, take, accept
