CAPVIII.

An ACT in ADDITION to an act, intitled an act for affesting, collecting and levying county rates.

1. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly,

HAT it shall and may be lawful for the Mayor, Alder-

Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of St. Jabn, impowered to appoint affelfors and collectors of rates and taxes.

Common Council convened, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appoint such and so many assessing, levying and collections as they in their discretion shall think sit for the assessing, levying and collecting all such rates, taxes and assessing, levying and collecting all such rates, taxes and assessing upon the inhabitants of the said City by virtue of the said recited act, or of any other law for raising or assessing any sum or sums of money upon the inhabitants of the said city. And such assessing to be appointed, and all such assessor as have been heretofore appointed by the said common Council by virtue of any law of this province, shall be and they are hereby made subject and liable to the same rules, regulations, restrictions, penalties and forseitures, as the assessor any town or parish in this province

are by law made subject and liable to. And all Collectors to be

appointed, or that have been already appointed by the faid com-

mon Council, shall be and they are hereby made subject and

liable to the same duties, rules, restrictions, regulations, penalties and forfeitures as any constables in any town or parish in this province are by the said herein before recited act made sub-

Such assessors subject to the same rules, penalties, &c. as parish assesfors.

And such collectors also subject to the same roles, penalities, &c. as constables are subject to.

Preamble.

HEREAS fome doubts have arisen concerning the conveyance of Dower by the wise, in her husband's life-time in the manner and form now in practice: In order therefore
