## CAP. VI.

An ACT to AMEND an Act, intituled " An Act for regulating the FISHERIES " in the different Rivers, Coves and " Creeks of this Province" fo far as the fame refpects the FISHERIES in that Part of the County of Northumberland which is within the Bay and River MIRAMICHI and it's Branches. Paffed the 12th MARCH, 1796.

HEREAS in and by an act made and paffed in the Preimble thirty third year of His MAJESTY's Reign intituled, " An Act for regulating the Fiftheries in the different Rivers, " Coves, and Greeks, of this Province" it is enacted " That the fisheries in that part of the county of Northumberland which is within the Bay and River Miramichi and its branches shall · be regulated in the manner therein after mentioned, that is to · fay, that the Juffices of the Peace in the faid county in their • hr/t General Sections in each year shall divide the faid Bay and • River Miramichi and its branches as nearly as may be into five equal diffricts according to the number of permanent Settlers, e and thall appoint a certain time and place for the Inhabitants f of each refpective diffrict to meet and choose two perfons the · best qualified for that purpose from their knowledge of the fisheries and situation of the Bay and River, all which perfons, " fo chofen, shall forthwith meet together and proceed to make -"and form fuch Rules and Regulations for carrying on the fiftheries fo far as refpects the length of Nets in the faid Bay and • River, as they or the majority of them thall think the beft and most proper to be adopted for the year enfuing; which Rules and Regulations are to be returned and fubmitted to • the faid Juffices in their General Seliions to be held for that · purpose to be by the faid Juffices either rejected or approved of, · confirmed and eftablished under such penalties and torfeitures, " not exceeding the fum of ten pounds, as to the faid Juffices shall feem meet and neceffary for carrying the fame into execution; and that fuch rules and regulations thall be obferved and obeyed • by the Overfeers of the Fifheries to be, by the faid Juffices, ap-· pointed in the feveral diffricts agreeable to the provisions of that aû

• act in the fame manner as if the tame Rules and Regulations • were therein and thereby particularly established and enacted. AND WHEREAS great inconveniencies have been experienced from the annual Election of Persons to form such Rules and Regulations agreeable to the faid provisions of the faid herein before recited act : AND WHEREAS certain Rules and Regulations have been made and confirmed at a Special Settions of the Peace held for the county of Northumberlandon the twenty fixth, twenty feventh and twenty eighth days of January one thousand seven hundred and ninety five agreeable to the provisions of the faid herein before recited act; and it is expedient that the fame should be continued without alterations for the term of three years.—

Regulations made in the month of Janeary 1795, to remain in force until the 1st. of January 1799.

I. BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Affembly, That the Rules and Regulations which have been returned and fubmitted to the Juffices of the Peace for the county of Northumberland at the faid Spesial Seffions herein before mentioned, and by them approved of, confirmed, and eftablished to be observed shall be and remain in full force until the *fir/t* day of January which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand feven bundred and ninety nine and no longer, any thing in the taid herein before recited act to the contrary notwithstanding.

II. And be it further enacled, That the faid herein before recited act and every claufe, matter and thing therein contained, except wherein the fame is hereby altered, fhall be and remain in full force, any thing herein before contained to the contrary notwith ftanding. PROVIDED, That nothing in this act contained fhall extend or be conftrued to extend to authorize the General Seffions of the Peace for the county of Northumberland to eftablish a Net across the South Weft branch of the river Miramichi, or to do any act or thing which shall in any way affect, abridge, extend, ar alter the right of Fishery claimed at that place by the Heirs or Affigns, or Widow of the late William Davidfon, Esquire, deceased or of any other person or persons whomsoever, any thing in the before recited act to the contrary notwith standing.
