## CAP. XV.

AN ACT for granting AID in SUPPORT of the COLLEGE of NEW-BRUNSWICK, incorporated by CHARTER and established at FREDERICTON. Passed the 5th of March, 1805.

**B**E it enacted by the PRESIDENT, Council and Assembly, That there be included from time to time and at all times in the estimate of the Ordinary Expense of this Province, the annual sum of One Hundred Pounds, and that the same be granted to the Governor and Trustees of the College in Fredericton, to be applied by them towards the Tuition of the Pupils of the said College. *Provided always*, that when the Funds of the said College shall amount to One Thousand Pounds annually, then and in that case the said Grant of One Hundred Pounds shall cease and determine.

£100 per annum granted to the Trustees of the College,

to cease when the Funds of the College amount to £1000 per an.

## CAP. XVI.

AN ACT to CONTINUE an Act made and passed in the Thirty-sixth Year of His MAJESTY'S reign, intituled, "An Act for regulating, laying out and repairing HIGHWAYS and ROADS." Passed the 5th of March, 1805.
