TATHEREAS Importations have been, and still are made into this Province, chiefly for exportation; and whereas it is expedient to lay a duty on such imports for the purpose of encreasing the Revenue.

I. Be it enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That Articles imported all articles hereafter imported or brought into this Province from from the Sines fubjest to five the United States, be, and are hereby made subject and liable per cent duty. to a duty of five per cent on the amount or value thereof, estima-

ted at the first cost or value. Provided always, that no Sheep Excepting provid or Neat Cattle, or other articles under the description of Provisions, shall be subject to any duty.

CAP. XXXIII.

An ACT to continue the eftablishment of County Schools, as provided for by an A&, intituled "An Act for encouraging and extending Literature in this Province." Passed the 14th of March, 1810.

Preamble

THEREAS in and by the ninth, tenth, eleventh, twelfth, and thirteenth Sections of an Act made and passed in the forty fifth year of His MAJESTY's Reign, intituled "An "Act for encouraging and extending Literature in this Pro-" vince," provision is made for establishing for six years, Schools in the several Counties in this Province. And whereas it is expedient that the said establishment be further continued.

Be it therefore enacted by the President, Council, and Assem-Continued for five gibe of bly, That the said establishment of County Schools, and the March, 1811. Provision made for the same as aforesaid, be, and the same is hereby continued for the further term of five years from the fifth day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven.
