## CAP. XVIII.

An Act to authorize the Justices of the General Sessions of the Peace for the County of York, to levy an assessment for building a County Court-House.

Passed the 11th of March, 1816.

THEREAS no building has yet been erected within the reamble County of York, for the accommodation of the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Court of Common Pleas for the said County: And WHEREAS the Justices of the General Sessions of the Peace of the said County, have heretofore levied the whole sum which they were empowered to raise, for the purposes of erecting a Gaol and Court-House in the said County, and necessarily applied the same to the sole purpose of erecting a Gaol: And WHEREAS it is expedient that a Court-House should be erected in the said County; Be it therefore enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, Justices at a General or Special That the said Justices of the Peace for the said County at any ment and exceeding &coo. General Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden, or Special Sessions for that purpose expressly convened and holden, are hereby authorized and empowered to make a further rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding the sum of six hundred pounds, as they in their discretion may think necessary for the purpose of erecting and finishing a Court-House for the said County, in the Town of Fredericton, the same sum to be assessed, levied, collected and paid in such proportion, Mode of collection and in the same manner as any other County rates can or may be assessed, levied collected and paid by virtue of an Act made and passed in the twenty sixth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled " An Act for assessing, collecting and levying County rates," or any other act now or hereafter to be made for the like purpose.

## CAP. XIX.

An Act to continue certain Acts of the General Assembly which are near expiring.
