An ACT to prevent the further Issuing and Circulation of Treasury Notes. . Passed the 24th of March, 1819.

X THEREAS it has been' found expedient Y : to prevent the further issuing and circu- Preamble. lation of Notes, under and by virtue of the pro- 58, 53 care visions of an Act made and passed in the fiftyeighth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to provide for punctuality of payment " at the Treasury:".

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That from and after the passing of this Act, no further payments be made at No further payments to be made the Treasury of this. Province in Notes, or any at the Treasury of this. Province in Notes, or any at the Treasury in Notes, be issued on any account whatever, under Notes to be issued. and by virtue of the provisions of the herein before recited Act; but that as often hereafter as money shall become due or payable, and Warrants he produced for payment of the same at the Treasury, the Treasurer shall pay the amount of such The Transmiss Warrants

CAP. II.

An ACT to make perpetual several Acts of the General Assembly which are near expiring. Passed the 24th of March. 1819.

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Coun-D cil, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the fifty-seventh year of His Majesty's The Act for ap- Reign, intituled " An Act for appointing Fire-" Wards in the Towns of Fredericton and Saint "Andrews, and ascertaining their power and " duty, and more effectually to prevent Fires in " the said Towns" --- And also an Act made and passed in the fifty-seventh year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act in amendment of an " an Act intituled " An Act more effectually to prevent the encumbering or filling up of Har-"bours, and to authorize the appointment of " Harbour Masters"--- be, and the same are hereby made perpetual.

CAP. III.

An ACT to authorize the Justices of the Peace for the City and County of Saint John, to levy an Assessment on the Inhabitants of the said City, for the purpose of building a Pour House in the said City.
