

## CAP. XVII.

An ACT for laying a Duty on all Teas imported into this Province.

Passed the 24th of March, 1819.

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That there be, and hereby is granted to the King's Most Excellent Majesty, his heirs and successors, for the use of this Province, and for the support of the Government thereof, a duty of one penny for every pound of Tea which shall or may be brought or imported into any port or place within this Province, to be paid by the importer or importers thereof; and that the same shall be collected and received in the same manner, and under and subject to the same rules, regulations, penalties and forfeitures, in all respects, as are prescribed and provided by an Act, made and passed in the fifty-eighth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province."

Duty of one penny per pound on all Teas imported.

To be collected in the same manner as provided in the Revenue Act of 58th Geo. 3.

II. And be it further enacted, that this Act shall remain and be in force until the first day of April, which will be in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty.

## CAP. XVIII.
