CAP. XVII.

An ACT in addition to an Act, intituled "An Act for the better extinguishing Fires which may happen in the Towns of Frederiction and Saint Andrews."

Passed the 21st March, 1822.

HEREAS by an Act passed in the fifty-second year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled "An Act in further addition to an "Act, intituled "An Act for the better ex-"tinguishing fires that may happen within "the City of Saint John," the registered Firemen within the said City of Saint John, are exempted and free from all Statute Labour on the Highways and Streets within the said City: And whereas it is proper and expedient to extend the same exemptions to the Firemen in the Towns of Fredericton and Saint Andrews---

Registered Firemen exempted from Highway Labour. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the registered Firemen of the said Towns of Fredericton and Saint Andrews, shall be, and they are hereby exempted and free from all Statute Labour on the Highways and Streets within the said Towns of Fredericton and Saint Andrews respectively, during their continuance in the office of Firemen, any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.

## CAP. XVIII.

An ACT further to continue the Acts, for more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in the City and County of St. John.

Passed the 21st March, 1822.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act 50 Geo. 3, c. 16, made and passed in the fiftieth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third.
