An Act to alter the division line between the Parishes of Dundas and Wellington in the County of Kent.

Passed 5th April, 1828.

THEREAS the dividing line of the two Parishes of Dundas and Wellington, Preamble. in the County of Kent, is by a line running through the middle of the River Mahalawadiaci and which has been found inconvenient to the inhabitants of the said Parishes.

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That hence Division Line alforth the division line between the said Parishes tered and describshall commence at the sand Bank or Shore on the Northerly line of lot number eight, originally granted to Joseph Richard; thence following the course of the North line of said lot number eight, until it strikes the East Boundary. II. Provided always, and be it further enucted, That the enlargement of the said Parish of Wellington, as herein before provided, shall not operate, or be construed to operate, to release release persons or any person or persons who heretofore belonged property from the to the said Parish of Dundas, or any property nalies or assesswhich heretofore was situated in the same Parish, ments heretofore and which will by this Act be placed in the Parish of Wellington, from the payment of any penalty incurred, or any assessment which may have been made before the passing of this Act; but the same may be recovered as if this Act had not been made.
