An Act to regulate the appointment of County Treasurers.

Passed 10th February, 1829.

Preamble.

HEREAS it is deemed expedient and proper that no Justice of the Peace, or Clerk of any Sessions, in and for any County in . this Province, shall hold, or be appointed to the situation of Treasurer of such County:

and Clerks of Sessions from holding ty Treasurer.

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Go-Prohibits Justices vernor, Council and Assembly, That no Justice of the Peace, or Clerk of any Sessions, in and for the office of Coun- any County in this Province, shall hold or be appointed to the situation of Treasurer of such County.

CAP. XVI.

An Act to continue an Act intituled, "An Act to empower the Justices of the County of Charlotte to make regulations for driving Timber and Logs down the Rivers Saint Croix, Magaguadavic, Digdeguash, and their Branches.

Passed 10th February, 1829.

E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor. Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the eight year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to empower the Justices of the County of Charlotte to make regalations for driving Timber and Logs down the Rivers Saint Croix, Magaguadavic, Digdeguash. and their Branches, be, and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force, until the first day of April which will be in the Year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

Continues the 8th Geo. 4, c. 15, till 1st. April 1833.
